Pursuant to Section 29.160, subsection (e), of Senate Bill 76 of the 78th Legislative Session, the Children's Learning Institute is pleased to present the following report:

The Texas School Ready! Project: Preparing Young Texans to Learn

The *Texas School Ready! Project* is the result of six years of legislative support matched by equally vigorous community efforts across Texas to prioritize “school readiness” –in short, to make sure that young Texans start school “prepared to learn.” The Texas Early Education Model (TEEM) and the Texas School Readiness Certification System (SRCS), both focus on increasing children’s school readiness through research-based curriculum, technology-driven child progress monitoring, and teacher/staff professional development with mentoring.

Central to the success of the *Texas School Ready! Project* is a sustainable, cost-effective approach that leverages local funds to prioritize school readiness as a “community” responsibility. Accordingly, the project integrates public school programs with federal Head Start programs and community-based child care in order to support the school readiness of at-risk, 3 and 4 year-old children.

Texas Early Education Model (TEEM)

Overview

In Texas and in other states across the country, millions of children arrive in kindergarten lacking basic school readiness. As a result, achievement gaps between at-risk and non-at-risk student populations start early and, as history suggests, continue throughout the course of many of these students’ education experiences. Most early childhood education entities (child care providers, public school districts, and Head Start programs) are deeply committed to their mission of working with young children at risk for school failure. Since 2003, when TEEM was initially piloted statewide, local communities have advanced substantially toward collaborative efforts to address the need to effectively prepare children for school success.

Growth

Since the project began, TEEM communities across the state have responded by rethinking the way they prepare their youngest Texans for school. Community-based partnerships have been developed and required to implement coherent, comprehensive, cost-conscious and scientifically research-based approaches toward school readiness for young children throughout Texas.

TEEM Demand at a Glance

The first TEEM grants in 2003 were small, serving some 2,100 students in 11 communities. Since that time, demand for TEEM has increased dramatically each year. For the 2008-2009 school year there are more than 61,000 students in 38 communities across Texas who are being prepared to learn, and thousands of more students are waiting for TEEM to become an option in their neighborhood.

Effectiveness

Throughout the life of the Texas School Ready! Project, careful attention has been focused to ensure that the children participating in the project are achieving and demonstrating progress in key literacy skills domains, namely phonological awareness, rapid letter naming, and vocabulary development. The Appendices included in this report demonstrate child outcome results according to Texas House of Representatives Member Districts, Texas Senate Member Districts, Regional Education Service Centers (ESCs), as well as Texas School Districts. These results indicate that children who participate in TEEM classrooms demonstrate significant gains on key predictors of early literacy. The key to these gains is the TEEM approach, which helps teachers and care-givers to provide learning activities that are age-appropriate for children and are, in the language of TEEM: “planful, purposeful and playful.”

The success of TEEM is evident. *Edvance Research, Inc.*, an independent research organization, recently conducted a third party, objective evaluation of the TEEM model, sponsored by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). *Edvance* was charged with gathering data in an effort to assess how effective TEEM has been in local communities throughout the state. The final evaluation supports three key findings grounded in a balanced examination of available statistical evidence. These key findings include:

- **The TEEM Model Positively Influences Teacher Quality**
- **The Longer You Are a TEEM Teacher, the Better You Get**
- **Not Only Do the Teachers Benefit, but So Do the Kids**

Other findings from the evaluation include:

“Alliances were achieved with a good mix of participation by different agencies.”

“Children that typically have access to fewer resources due to geographic location were served through the TEEM program.”

“Reportedly, through interagency integration, districts decreased the number of overcrowded classrooms which provided a more cohesive environment for teachers and they felt rejuvenated.”

Edvance’s President and senior researchers associated with the evaluation noted:

“That the TEEM project is showing clear and measurable improvements for students on the three skill areas that years of evidence-based research have demonstrated are linked to school readiness for at-risk children, specifically rapid letter naming, rapid vocabulary naming and phonological awareness is not in question.”

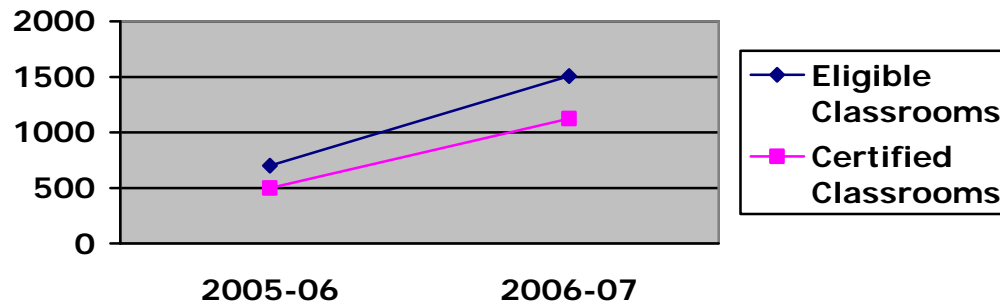
Texas School Readiness Certification System (SRCS)

In 2005, the 79th Texas Legislature passed a unanimous, sweeping early childhood educational reform to establish the Texas School Readiness Certification System (SRCS), which provides parents with critical information about whether public and private early childhood programs are preparing their children for success in kindergarten. The State Center for Early Childhood Development at the Children’s Learning Institute partnered with TEEM communities across the state to develop and pilot the system successfully throughout the Texas , and since inception the total number of early childhood programs achieving certification and being recognized as *Texas School Ready!*TM has significantly increased.



Most recently, over a thousand *Texas School Ready!*TM designations were awarded to early childhood classrooms that are teaching our most vulnerable children the academic and social skills they need to be successful in school. Perhaps most exciting is that the School Readiness Certification System works across all three programs serving young children. Due to the vision of the legislature, SRCS was designed to work universally in public school classrooms, Head Start classrooms and child care classrooms. The 2008 SRCS results reflect this universality, with 63% of participating Head Start classrooms certified, 65% of child care classrooms certified, and 85% of public school classrooms certified. Texas now has the best system in the nation to inform parents and other stakeholders about the quality of their early childhood programs; a system that links early childhood program data and child outcome data in kindergarten.

The next graph shows the increase in the number of preschool classrooms that were eligible to be considered for certification (i.e., all necessary information was submitted) from the first year (2005-06) to the second year of the program (2006-07); as well as the increase from the first to the second year in the number of classrooms earning *Texas School Ready!*TM certification.



Future Goals

- Increase access for more families and children to participate in community-based TEEM school readiness integration partnerships.
- Increase access for more early childhood programs to participate in the Texas School Readiness Certification System (SRCS).
- Integrate all of the current State Board of Education adopted kindergarten assessment instruments so that non-TPRI (Texas Primary Reading Inventory) school districts can participate in the SRCS. While most school districts use the TPRI in grades K-2 to monitor child progress in literacy, there are increased instances of school districts using alternative literacy assessments. Currently, the SRCS is set-up to only capture data from districts that use the TPRI.
- To complement the early literacy and social-emotional components of TEEM and SRCS, the Children's Learning Institute has developed a mathematics screener to assess child readiness for success in early mathematics. This exciting development will allow Texas to be the only state in the nation that can assess early childhood program quality in three, distinct skills domains: literacy, social-emotional, and math.
- As the State Center for Early Childhood Development, provide technical assistance to all providers of early childhood education to ensure that ALL children are prepared to succeed in school.
